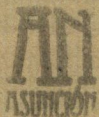

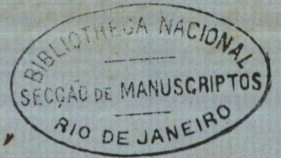
The agent at Buenos Ayres,

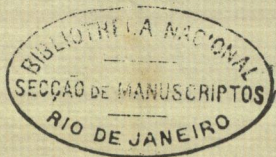
