to inform your Excellency, that the Tacuari arrived here this day at 4 P.M. after a hard tug with the "Bormigo" from Chimbolar Canal yesterday, & the Brig and Galata de Guerra "Paraguay" from Corrientes today.

I consider it proper to acquaint your Excellency, that the Captain of the "Bormigo" has thrown away much valuable time, & neglected his duty, in not weighing anchor & making sail from Chimbolar on the 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> when he had a good strong fair wind; & no less than 6 Bepels arrived who were much farther down the Parana than the "Bormigo". I have not had time to question him on this neglect, but no doubt your Excellency will investigate the matter, on his arrival at Asuncion. The Coal burns so very badly, that I have determined to take in wood here - I shall leave at 4 A.M. tomorrow, & hope to see your Excellency before this arrives.

My best thanks are due to Col. & Chief Petty, for his always kind & ready assistance to me, & also the Captain of Port.

Sir, I have the honor
